**Do You Have What it Takes to Become a Ski Patroller?** IFMGA means International Federated Mountain Guides Associations and is the english translation of Union Internationale des Associations de Guide de Montagne (UIAGM). IFMGA guides are given a pin, and a card, identifying them as a licensed guide. The process of obtaining IFMGA credentials can cost upwards of \$30,000 and takes about 5 years.
